The U.S. Embassy is pleased to announce the 2020 Hubert Humphrey Fellowship Program. This one year, full-scholarship program is offered to mid-career professionals working at the policy-level who have a record of leadership, a commitment to public service, and the initiative to take full advantage of an independent study at a leading American university. The Hubert H. Humphrey Fellowship Program brings accomplished professionals from developing countries to the United States at a midpoint in their careers for a one-year of non-degree study and related professional activities. The program seeks to foster an exchange of knowledge and mutual understanding between American citizens and professional counterparts from Algeria. Successful applicants will be placed at participating universities in the United States starting June - August 2020 period.

Fields of Study: Fellowships are available in the following fields:

Sustainable Development

- a. Agricultural and Rural Development
- b. Economic Development/Finance and Banking
- c. Natural Resources, Environmental Policy, and Climate Change
- d. Urban and Regional Planning

Democratic Institution Building

- a. Communications/Journalism
- b. Law and Human Rights
- c. Public Policy Analysis and Public Administration
- d. Trafficking in Persons Policy and Prevention
- e. Technology Policy and Management
- f. Human Resource Management

Education

- a. Educational Administration, Planning and Policy

Eligibility Requirements: To be eligible for the Humphrey Fellowship, applicants must:

- Be Algerian citizens;
- Hold a Bachelor of Arts or Science Degree;
- A minimum of five years of full-time, professional experience (no “stages” will be considered);
- Demonstrated leadership qualities and a record of public service in the community;
- English language ability as measured by TOEFL IBT (minimum score of 71 score on TOEFL test);
- Limited or no prior experience in the United States
- A commitment to returning to Algeria after completing the program and a clear vision on how Fellow, home institution, and Algeria will benefit from the Hubert Humphrey experience;

PROCESS AND SELECTION CRITERIA:

The Humphrey Fellowships are highly competitive, and applicants must fulfill the eligibility criteria outlined above.

HOW TO APPLY: Candidates who meet the above criteria are encouraged to fill out an application via the online application system, and upload the following documents.

- Online application
- Copy of diploma along with its translated certified version
- Three letters of recommendation
- TOEFL score report of a minimum of 71 (TOEFL IBT). Nominees should register to take the TOEFL no later than August 20, 2019.
- Copy of the university academic transcripts and English-language, translated certified version
- Work of experience of minimum of 5 years (copy of work certificate and English-language translated certified version);

- Resume
